



Korčula & Pelješac - Deep in Dalmatian wine country

Two destinations in the Dubrovnik County that come to mind when one thinks of wine are the Pelješac peninsula and the island of Korčula. The scenic peninsula of Pelješac stretches out like a green finger into the Adriatic Sea. Picturesque vineyards cling to the rocky slopes dotted between the thick Mediterranean vegetation. Just a short ferry ride brings you to an island steeped in history, an island with a walled city- the island of Korčula. A day trip to these jewels of the Croatia coastline will leave you awestruck at their natural beauty and spellbound with their historical roots.

14:45 - 15:10 Drive to a local winery
15:10 - 15:50 Presentation and wine tasting
15:50 - 18:00 Drive back to Dubrovnik
