Recommended Airports

BOS

Boston Logan International

~90 miles · 1.5-2.5 hrs

PVD

Rhode Island T.F. Green International Airport

~85 miles · 1.5-2 hrs

Transportation Options

Rental Car **Recommended**

Time & Cost: ~1 hr 45 min · \$60-\$150 USD/day · Free parking at resort

Available at both Boston Logan and Providence airports.

The most flexible option – highly recommended if you plan to explore Cape Cod during your stay, as towns, restaurants, and beaches are spread out across the peninsula.

Rideshare (Uber / Lyft)

Time & Cost: BOS: ~2 hrs, \$200-\$300 · PVD: ~1.5-2 hrs, \$150-\$250 USD

Available from both airports, though off-season availability in Brewster can be limited and surge pricing may apply.

Private Car Service

Time & Cost: BOS & PVD: 1.5-2.5 hrs, \$250-\$350 USD/vehicle

Door-to-door service direct to Ocean Edge Resort. A comfortable and reliable option, particularly useful for groups. Accessible vehicles available on request when booking.

Ferry & Bus **Only available from Boston Logan Airport (BOS)**

Ferry (Boston → Provincetown, Cape Cod)

Time & Cost: Seasonal · Check schedule ~1.5-2 hrs · \$70-\$120 USD roundtrip

Bay State Cruise Company runs daily service May 16-Oct 18, with weekend service through Nov 15. Scenic but requires an additional ~1 hour drive from Provincetown to Brewster – best paired with a rental car or pre-arranged transfer.

Bus

Time & Cost: ~3-3.5 hours total · \$50-\$90 USD

Take Peter Pan Bus or Plymouth & Brockton from Boston Logan to Hyannis Transportation Center, then a 30-minute taxi or rideshare to the resort. The most budget-friendly option – book ahead as fall schedules are limited.

Quick Tips

Book early

Off-season schedules are limited – reserve car service and rentals as soon as travel is confirmed.

Share the ride

Coordinate with colleagues at the same airport. A shared private car is often more cost-effective.

Plan your return
